Be considerate of everyone's differences and respect the rights and viewpoints of others.
Behave honestly and treat all students fairly, equally and with respect.
Strive to provide a safe and inclusive environment that is free from discrimination, bullying and intimidation.
Provide opportunities for feedback and inform students how feedback has been incorporated into the school's processes of continuous improvement.
Provide fair, open and efficient complaints and appeals procedures.
